How To Secure More Sales And Clients Using FREE Search Engine Marketing

With the economy tanking and businesses looking to cut costs every way possible, it only makes sense that many are focusing more attention on using free social media marketing to fuel sales and new customers. After all, almost everyone uses the Internet to research a company before buying from them; and if you are not coming up in the local searches, you are definitely missing out on a number of potential prospects who are ready to buy what you sell.

While there are dozens—if not hundreds—of strategies for being found online, I believe you have to walk before you run. To that end, here are a few simple, key strategies you can use immediately to improve your search engine ranking locally.

#1: Add yourself to the local search engine pages:

#2. Figure out a handful of “seed” keywords you will focus on.

While many online marketers will tell you to have hundreds if not thousands of keywords, the reality is that there are only a few key search terms people will be looking for.

The goal is to get 10 very well selected TARGET keyword phrases that will be worth the effort. These target keyword phrases should provide enough traffic, a spot on SERPs (search engine results pages) that you can potentially get top ranking in, and will provide the type of targeted traffic you most want.

Use your **KEYWORD PHRASES** in:

- ♦ Page TITLES
- ♦ Page <H1> headers
- ♦ Sparse bold or <i> italic words
- ♦ Internal linking (Coordinate things so that they match up; linked TEXT must go to a page with the same keywords in the TITLE)
- ♦ External links coming into your site such as Twitter, YouTube videos, your blog (if hosted on an external web site), etc.

#3. Add a blog to your web page and update it with a new article or post at least once a week.

One of the best is WordPress; however, you will need help from a web master to set it up. Another option is to set up a blog at www.Posterous.com or Blogger.com, which you can easily do in a few minutes.

Whatever you choose, make sure you write relevant, keyword dense articles that link back to your main web site.

How To Get Spell Checker To Work In Outlook Express:

We get lots of questions from clients that use Outlook Express for e-mail, but can't get the spell checker to work. That's because Outlook Express depends on Microsoft Office for the spell checker function. If you don't have Microsoft Office installed or if you upgraded to Office 2007 you're out of luck... until now.

This problem can be fixed with a free, simple-to-install utility that adds a public domain dictionary to any version of Outlook Express. You'll amaze and impress your friends and colleagues with your new-found ability to spell. Here's how: Type the following URL into your web browser's address bar:

When prompted to run or save choose run. If your only choice is save then save the file in My Documents. If you chose run, you're finished; if you saved it, open My Documents and double click on the file you saved. True Story: Don't Let This Happen To Your Company!



Here's a true story with the names changed to protect the innocent...

During Friday's lunch break, Peggy ate lunch at her desk so she could surf the Internet for coupons to cash in over the weekend. She discovered that she needed to temporarily disable her anti-virus software so a coupon printer could be installed. She felt it was innocent enough because the web site explained this was a common step in the process of accessing the coupons. Besides, she really wanted those \$25 dollars in savings!

Later that night at the grocery store, Peggy discovers her coupons are worthless counterfeits. That's because they were printed from a coupon web site designed to fool the end user into downloading a program that would connect her computer to a network of bots (also called a botnet). This network of illegally hacked computers is used to flood the Internet (and your inbox) with spam.

When Peggy got in Monday morning, she discovered the company's entire e-mail server was blacklisted as a spam source stopping ALL e-mail communications internally, as well as to clients and vendors. It took two full days to discover the source of the spam, clean up the mail server, and begin the process of removing Peggy's company from the blacklist at clients, vendors and various anti-spam monitoring services. It took another two weeks before everything was back to normal.

Don't let this happen to you! This episode could have been prevented with properly installed and monitored anti-malware software, an anti-malware network appliance and an acceptable use policy in place for all employees to follow. There are more than 12 million zombie computers in the United States alone. If your network hasn't been attacked yet, it will. Though this numbers game is rigged in favor of the bad guys, you don't have to let it destroy your company's productivity and good reputation!

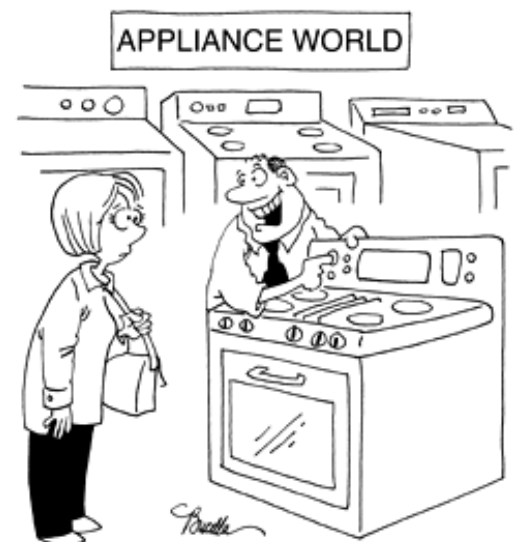
